Gloria is one of our cleft-palate babies. 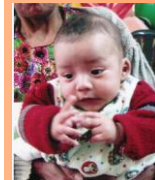

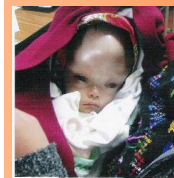
